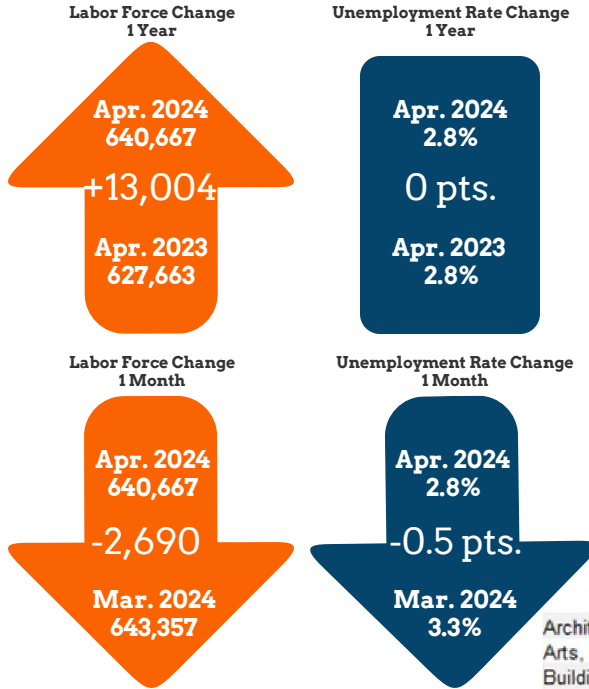

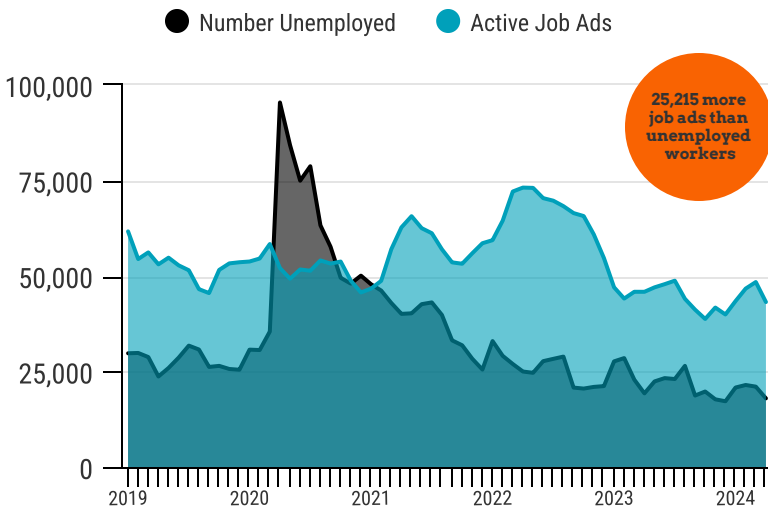

In April 2024, there is **more than one (2.4x)** active online job advertisement for every unemployed worker in Allegheny County.

The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In Apr. 2024, there were **5.9% less** online job advertisements in all occupations compared to Apr. 2023. Apr. 2024 had a **10.8% decrease in online job ads** compared to Mar. 2024. Computer and Mathematical occupations had the **largest YoY negative change** in non-military job ads with **32.7% fewer online job ads** in Apr. 2024 compared to Apr. 2023. With job advertisements **down 5.9%** between Apr. 2024 and Apr. 2023, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
