



The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In January 2025, there were **0.4% fewer** online job advertisements in all occupations compared to January 2024. January 2025 had an **11.5% increase in online job ads** compared to December 2024. Healthcare Practitioners and Technical occupations had the **largest YoY negative change** in job ads with **35.6% fewer online job ads** in January 2025 compared to January 2024. Even though job advertisements are down **0.4%** between January 2024 and January 2025, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
