Labor Force Change 1 Year



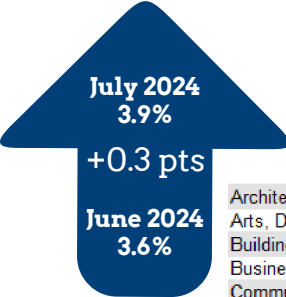
Unemployment Rate Change 1 Year



Labor Force Change 1 Month

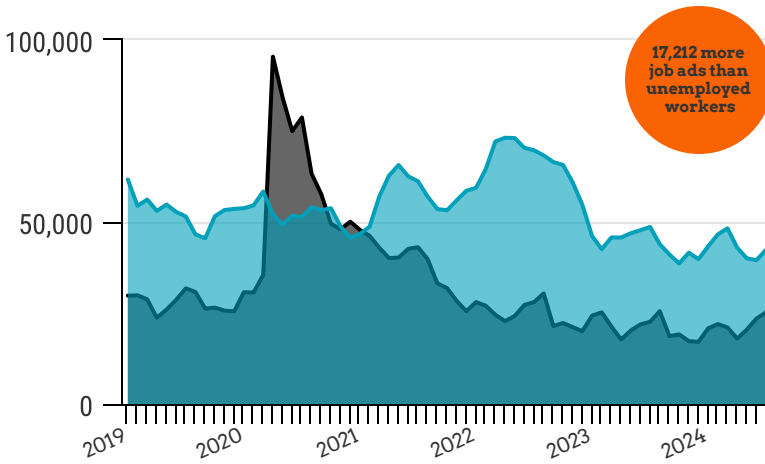


Unemployment Rate Change 1 Month

The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In July 2024, there were **12.8% less** online job advertisements in all occupations compared to July 2023. July 2024 had an **8.1% increase in online job ads** compared to June 2024. Production occupations had the **largest YoY negative change** in job ads with **22.6% fewer online job ads** in July 2024 compared to July 2023. While job advertisements are **down 12.8%** between July 2023 and July 2024, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
