

The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In September 2024, there were 6.4% more online job advertisements in all occupations compared to September 2023. September 2024 had a 0.6% increase in online job ads compared to August 2024. Military occupations had the largest YoY negative change in job ads with 20.0% fewer online job ads in September 2024 compared to September 2023. With job advertisements up 6.4% between September 2023 and

September 2024, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
